Equality objectives 2018 – 2022

- 1) Raise the profile of and celebrate diversity across the federation through
 - creating displays focused on the cultural heritage of our families
 - exploiting opportunities in the curriculum to look at other cultures/countries e.g. explorers book
 - studying famous people from ethnic minorities and those with disabilities e.g. black history month, Paralympics
 - using collective worship as an opportunity to celebrate festivals from a range of cultures and countries e.g. Chinese new year, Diwali.

- 3) Continue as a fully inclusive federation, proving on a daily basis that disability is no barrier to playing a full and active role in society.
 - Model this through our open admissions criteria
 - Provide strong support for each other on a daily basis in order for every child to meet their full potential
