

# **Freedom of Information**

## **Guide to information available from The Federation of Lower Halstow School and Newington CEP School**

**Agreed Strategy 2014 – Review Autumn 2019**

**Since 01 January 2005 there has been a legal right for any person to make a request to a school for access to information held by that school.**

**Schools are under a duty to provide advice and assistance to anyone requesting information and must respond to the enquiry promptly, and in any event, within 1-month (not working or school days but calendar days, irrespective of school holiday periods). However, the month does not begin until further information to assist you with the request (i.e. about identity) is received.**

**The DCSF recommends that schools respond to straightforward requests for free and charge where the costs are significant. The Governing Body should delegate to the Executive Headteacher the day-to-day responsibility for FOI policy and the provision of advice, guidance, publicity and interpretation of the school's policy. This does not apply to any subject access request where access to an individual's personal information remains free of charge.**
