
Last term were:

In Literacy we learned through the story 'The Snail and the Whale'. This allowed us to do lots of role-play, acting in role as the characters and interviewing characters from the story. It also provided great opportunities for writing. We used adjectives to describe settings, wrote postcards and also a fact file on a whale.

In Maths we started the Term by focussing on Place Value. This meant we learnt language such as greater than, less than and equal to. We now understand one more and one less and can put numbers in order. We also became 'Shape detectives' and hunted around the school for 2D and 3D shapes.

In Topic our focus was History and our theme was 'Toys'. We thought about how toys are similar and different and how they have changed from the past. We created our own timelines and even explored some real toys from the past.

This term we are:



In Literacy we will be learning through the story of 'Beegu'. She is a friendly little alien! We will continue to develop our sentence structure and punctuation.

In Maths we will spend most of the Term focussing on addition and subtraction.
