Beech Class have had another brilliant term this term. They have all worked extremely hard in class and have produced some fantastic pieces of work over the term- I hope this continues when we return in January.

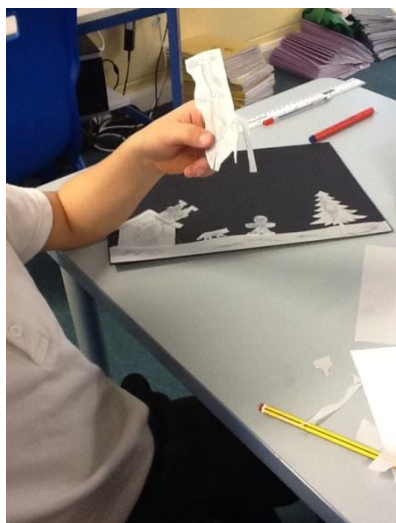
I hope you all have a well-deserved and enjoyable Christmas break and I look forward to seeing you all and continuing to work with you all in Term 3.
