music and dances.

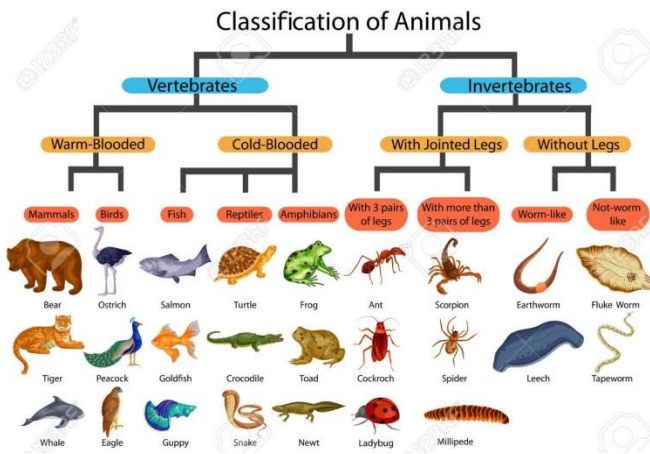
