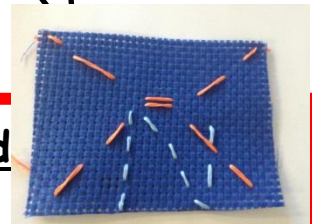


Maple Class Celebration Newsletter
