This term we have been:

In Literacy we have been learning through the story 'Ug'. This story book is in the style of a comic strip and we enjoyed looking at the features and acting in role. We created our own characters and put them into our very own comic strip stories.

In Maths we finished our topic of addition and subtraction by adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers and learning how to borrow and exchange. We are now much better at using the column method. We then moved onto multiplication and division and used our 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

In Topic we moved through Prehistory to the Bronze Age and Iron Age. We enjoyed learning how this period of history moved forward and how their lives changed for the better. We made our own Bronze Age clay houses and wrote our own fact sheets. I have been amazed at how much they have all learnt about Prehistory. I wonder if they can recall all the facts to you?
