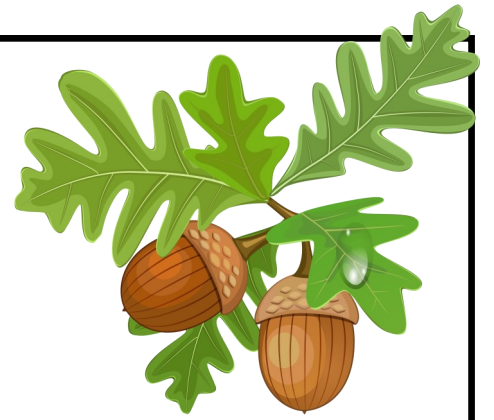


Acorn Class Newsletter

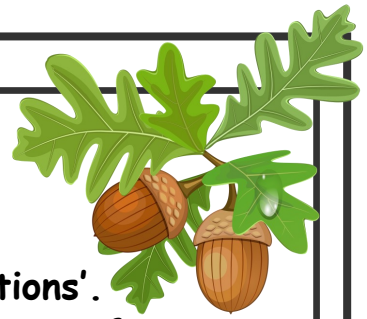
This term our learning has followed the themes of 'Ourselves' and 'Autumn'. Here are a few pictures to show what we have been up to
