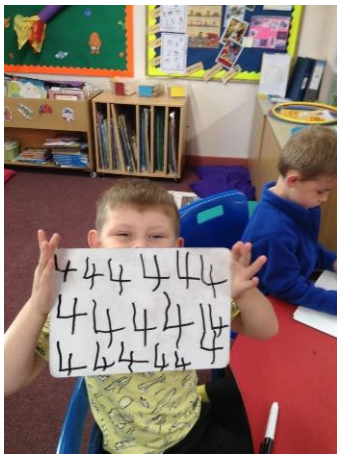


Rowan class celebration newsletter

In Maths the children will be doing Subtraction, Shape and Place Value to 20.

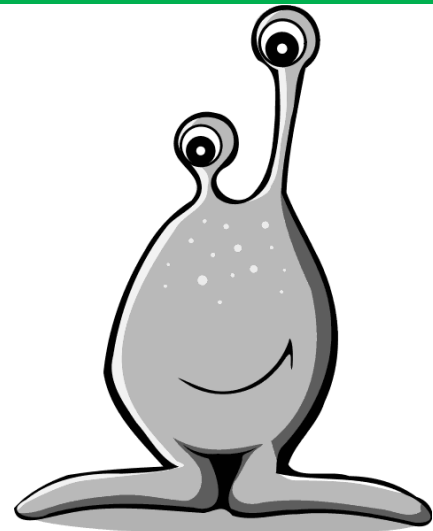
In Geography we will be learning about the worlds 7 continents and 5 oceans.
