This term we have been:

In Literacy this term we really enjoyed reading 'Stig of The Dump' by Clive King. We wrote diary entries as the character Barney, acted out main events and reviewed our favourite parts. The children showed great recall and enjoyed the dramatic events of the story.

In Maths, we have been learning about the place value of 3 digit numbers. We then used this knowledge to help us solve number problems such as comparing and ordering numbers. We finished the term by adding and taking away multiples of 10 and 100 with 3 digit numbers.

In Topic, we researched lots about The Stone Age and how life was in this prehistoric period. The children enjoyed finding out about Stone Age hunting techniques, cave art and the mystery of Stonehenge. I hope they have shared some of their new found facts with you!

Next term we are:

In Literacy we will be reading the book 'Ug' by Raymond Briggs. This book is presented in a comic strip style and we will be dramatizing parts of the story as well as inferring how the character acts and feels. In Maths we will be working on our calculation skills- addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. This will again be by using 3 digit numbers.

In Topic, our focus will be The Bronze Age and The Iron Age. We will discuss how the development of tools shifted society from The Stone Age to these new periods. We will also discuss where and how people lived during these eras.
