Term 2

In Maths our focus for the term has been on the four operations and fractions. After a busy term we can:

- Read, write, compare and order fractions.
- Explore fractions with the same and different numerators and denominators.
- Add, subtract and multiply fractions.
- Convert mixed numbers to improper fractions and simplify fractions.

In Literacy we read 'Kensuke's Kingdom, where we travelled the world with young Michael, trying to survive on a deserted island along with monkeys, his pet dog Stella and a man called Kensuke. We created missing posters and focussed on persuasive text to encourage others to come and visit the Island by writing our own trip reviews.

In Science we have been looking at living things and their habitats and learnt how to use and create our own classification keys.

For our P.E this term we worked with external coaches and learnt skills in bench ball.

Topic for Term 2 was geography which included learning about Biomes. We learnt about the different climates around the world and where we can locate rainforests and deserts, discovering the types of animals that live there and what it would be like.
