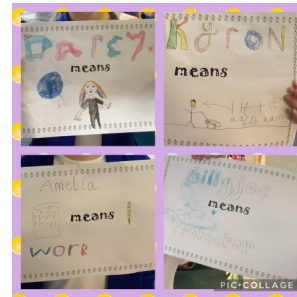




Other highlights:
