




Oak Class Newsletter

Term 4

In Maths our focus for the term was exploring position and direction. After a busy term we can:

- Read, represent and write numbers with 2 decimal places.
- Explore the relationship between decimals and fractions greater than 1.
- Convert between fractions and decimals.
- Multiply and divide up to 3 decimal places.

In Literacy we read *Benno and the Night of the Broken Glass*, following the journey of a cat through the streets of Berlin during WW2, creating non-chronological reports, book reviews and recounts. We also used figurative language, developed our writing skills further including a wider variety of vocabulary and sentence structure and created flashbacks against the short video called *The Piano*.



In Science we have been looking at famous scientists that have linked to areas of Science we have covered so far this year. We have written our own creative reports and created comic strips based on them. We have also experimented and created rubber band powered cars too!



Topic for Term 3 continued to be History where we continued learning about WW2. We learnt about Anne Frank and looked at different types of medals that were issued.



We have been learning how to play the Ukulele each week and are progressing well with our chord and fret knowledge.

For Art this term we explored using different types of media to create patterns, using stencils, vegetables and objects.

Science

In Science we will be learning about Electricity.

Topic

For Topic we will be learning about the history of Benin.

Maths

We will continue to cover areas such as decimals, percentages, algebra as well as calculating the area of a triangle and volumes of cubes and cuboids.

Literacy

We will be exploring our class text book— Benin Traditional Tales, and writing in different genres including narratives, persuasive writing, explanation texts and reports.
